SIF Transilvania informs that, through Decision no. 374/08.03.2016, the Brasov Court of Appeal rejected the application for revision filed by Mr. Constantin Fraţilă against the Civil Decision no. 1622 /Ap /27.11.2015 issued by the Brasov Court of Appeal – Civil Division in the File no. 4801/62/2014 and ordered Mr. Constantin Fraţilă to pay S.I.F. Transilvania the amount of RON 1,000 as court charges.

We recall that through Decision no. 1622/Ap/2015 the Brasov Court of Appeal found the abuse of minority committed by Mr. Constantin Fraţilă in relation to SIF Transilvania.
